POLICY

Community College of Vermont is a public non-profit institution designed to meet the education and training needs of its students. Tuition and fees are charged to cover a portion of the college's operating budget in an effort to maintain a positive working and learning environment.

PROCEDURES

1. Tuition levels are determined annually by the Vermont State Colleges Board of Trustees and are charged on a per credit basis for credit-bearing courses.
2. Fee levels are set annually by the president of the college in accordance with Vermont State Colleges guidelines and are charged for the following administrative services: registration, late registration, independent study, academic services, transcript evaluation, transcript requests, computer use, graduation, and assessment of prior learning.
3. Additional fees may be assigned when deemed appropriate by the college.
4. For non-credit training, special offerings, or contracted learning, the college reserves the right to set all fees and/or costs as it deems appropriate.
