BASIC FUNCTION

To recruit, place, and follow-up on students participating in the community service learning program; to establish service learning needs and training procedures, through collaboration with community agencies; and to support the day to day operations of the Center for Service Learning.

CHARACTERISITIC DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assess community needs for student volunteer opportunities, market opportunities and evaluate CSL programs.
- Recruit student volunteers and recognize volunteer efforts.
- Recruit, train, and supervise student leaders.
- Supervise AmeriCorps "education only" program and Federal Work Study Students.
- Work with JSC faculty to support the integration of service learning into curricula.
- Identify domestic and international alternative break locations and support student coordinators to manage all aspects of the program. Advise Break Away student leaders and participate on Break Away.
- Confer regularly with supervisor, student affairs staff and college personnel to plan and coordinate activities and programs with community service / service learning components (i.e., orientation, Upward Bound, residence life programming, wellness activities, etc.)
- Plan and conduct workshops on service learning to students, faculty, staff and community members.
- Plan and lead student leadership development (including Leaders Break Away, LEAD, etc.). Market state, regional and national leadership opportunities to students.
- Advise local schools, agencies, and other colleges on creating service learning programs.
- Perform other related tasks as assigned.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED

Minimal supervision is received from the Director of Nonprofit Management Studies.

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Minimum Qualifications

- Bachelors degree in an appropriate discipline, with three to five years of relevant experience, or a combination of education and experience from which comparable knowledge and skills are acquired.
- Familiarity with theory and methods used in experiential learning programs and service learning pedagogy.
- Familiarity with community agencies.
- Strong writing skills, administrative skills, counseling and advising skills.
