#### 3. Approval of Tuition, Fees, Room & Board Rates for the 2017-2018 Academic Year Trustee Hindes moved and Trustee Jerman seconded the resolution. After discussion, the Board voted to approve the resolution. Trustee Macfarlane voted against the resolution. The resolution

was approved (8 in favor, 1 opposed).

#### 4. Report of the Executive Committee

Chair O'Connor reported that the Executive Committee met, and referred Trustees to the minutes in the materials.

#### 5. Report of the Audit Committee

There was no report of the Audit Committee.

#### 6. Report of the Education, Personnel, and Student Life Committee

#### a. Consent agenda

#### 7. Report of the Finance & Facilities Committee

Trustee Hindes moved and Trustee Jerman seconded the resolution. Trustee Macfarlane voted against the resolution. The resolution was approved (9 in favor, 1 opposed).

#### 8. Report of the Long Range Planning Committee

 a. Chancellor's recommendations for next steps regarding alliances between Johnson State College and Lyndon State College, as well as Community College of Vermont and Vermont Technical College

Trustee Diamond moved and Trustee Luneau seconded the resolution. Chancellor Spaulding briefly reviewed his recommendations. The Board voted unanimously to approve the resolution *Chancellor's Recommendation to Unify Johnson State and Lyndon State Colleges*.

Chancellor Spaulding asked the Board for their preference regarding presidents reports. The Board decided that presidents should provide an annual report for the September retreat, but that reports for each Board meeting were no longer necessary.

WHEREAS,	Students, their families, and the Colleges all require and deserve timely and accurate information to plan for 2017-2018 academic costs and budgets; and
WHEREAS,	The Colleges have continued to work diligently to maximize revenue, decrease costs and maximize efficiencies to help minimize tuition, fees, room and board increases; and
WHEREAS,	As part of their revenue maximization efforts, the Colleges are acting upon the recommendation of their consultant, AGB Institutional Strategies, Inc., to set tuition for the 2017-2018 academic year during the summer of 2016; and
WHEREAS,	The Presidents have submitted tuition recommendations for their respective Colleges to the Chancellor based upon careful considerations both of their revenue requirements and their market perspectives; and
WHEREAS,	The Chancellor has considered the Presidents' tuition recommendations in the context of revenues and the corresponding budgetary impact for the entire Vermont State Colleges System; and
WHEREAS,	For the 2017-2018 academic year the Chancellor has proposed tuition, fees, room and board rates attached hereto; and
WHEREAS,	In accordance with Policy 403, <i>Annual Operating Budget</i> , the Board of Trustees is responsible for setting <u>maximum</u> tuition, fees, room and board rates, and the Colleges are responsible for setting tuition, fees, room and board rates that are at or below these rates; therefore be it
RESOLVED,	That the Finance and Facilities Committee of the Board of Trustees has reviewed and discussed the 2017-2018 academic year rate requests by Vermont State Colleges management, and endorses their approval to the full Board; therefore be it further
RESOLVED,	That the Board of Trustees of the Vermont State Colleges establishes for the 2017-2018 academic year the <u>maximum</u> tuition, fees, room and board rates attached hereto.

# VERMONT STATE COLLEGES BOARD OF TRUSTEES RESOLUTION

Chancellor's Recommendation to Unify Johnson State and Lyndon State Colleges

WHEREAS,	The Vermont State Colleges Board of Trustees recognizes that Lyndon State College and Johnson State College provide essential access to high-quality, affordable public higher education opportunities for students; and
WHEREAS,	The Board of Trustees recognizes that each campus is an important economic and cultural resource for their regions and the State of Vermont; and
WHEREAS,	The Board of Trustees is committed to ensuring that both campuses remain vibrant, viable, and vital for the long term; and
WHEREAS,	Many reliable sources, including Moody's Investors Service, predict that financial challenges caused by inadequate state financial support, demographic changes, increased expenses, and competition from new delivery modes will cause a significant increase in college closures across the country; and
WHEREAS,	Even as they provide high-quality programs, small, tuition-dependent colleges are particularly vulnerable to such financial challenges; and
WHEREAS,	The Board of Trustees recognizes the potential for a larger size institution to increase opportunities and supports for students with a more comprehensive curriculum, shared co-curricular learning opportunities, and more efficient use of support resources; and
WHEREAS,	The Board of Trustees recognizes the potential for a larger size institution to create a stronger, more diverse community of faculty and staff with more opportunities to draw upon and develop faculty and staff expertise; and
WHEREAS,	The Board of Trustees recognizes the potential for a larger size institution to achieve an improved economy of scale, redirecting valuable resources from administrative functions to the institutional mission; and
WHEREAS,	Chancellor Jeb Spaulding recommends that the Board unify Lyndon State College and Johnson State College under one administration, creating one


larger and stronger college with two distinct campuses, each with its own identity, with Dr. Elaine Collins as president at the time the unification takes place on July 1, 2017;
