ITEM 3: CCV Northern Lights Grant

CONTRACT FOR NORTHERN LIGHTS AT CCV

CCV has had a contract for over 15 years with Vermont Agency of Human Services, Department for Children and Families, Child Development (CDD) to offer professional development, career advising, and registry supports for over 8000 Vermont early childhood educators and afterschool professionals through Northern Lights at CCV.

There are currently 12 CCV staff members supporting the work of Northern Lights at CCV, and we anticipate one additional position for FY23.

CDD has indicated that CCV will receive a contract for Northern Lights at CCV for FY23 and will not be required to submit a competitive RFA. We do not know when that contract will be awarded but anticipate the amount will not exceed \$1.5 million.
