JOINT STATEMENT: NEW ENGLAND COMMISSION OF HIGHER EDUCATION AND THE VERMONT STATE COLLEGES SYSTEM

On June 17, 2022, the New England Commission of Higher Education (NECHE) accepted the substantive change proposal submitted by the Vermont State Colleges System to consolidate three separate institutions into Vermont State University, effective July 1, 2023. Vermont State University will bring together Castleton University, Northern Vermont University, and Vermont Technical College to form a single state-wide institution of higher education.

The VSCS proposal outlines a comprehensive, multi-year planning process which, if successfully implemented, NECHE has determined to be consistent with its *Standards for Accreditation*. Vermont State University will have five constituent primary campuses and will implement an innovative hybrid operational model designed to increase accessibility for learners. VSCS will be submitting two reports to NECHE over the upcoming academic year to document its progress in preparing for the July 1, 2023 launch of Vermont State University, as well as undergoing a focused evaluation by NECHE in Fall 2023. Accreditation for Vermont State University is contingent upon the successful implementation of its transformation plans, as determined by the Commission.
