RESOLUTION 2022-015

Approval of Vermont State University Tuition and Fees for AY 2023-2024

- WHEREAS, A critical goal of the Vermont State Colleges is affordability; and
- WHEREAS, Vermont State University has proposed a unified pricing model for the academic year 2023-2024 that lowers the published price of tuition; and
- WHEREAS, The proposed pricing model establishes a base tuition for all Vermont State University students, dependent upon program level; and
- WHEREAS, The proposed pricing model establishes a differential program fee for programs requiring lower faculty to student ratios or specialized technology and equipment; and
- WHEREAS, Vermont State University is committed to the strategic use of institutional aid (scholarships) for needy students and to drive specific programmatic goals; and
- WHEREAS, Institutional aid for current students will be adjusted to reflect the change in tuition, resulting in a net cost of attendance for a combined tuition plus program fee equal to or better than Academic Year 2022 - 2023; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the Board of Trustees of the Vermont State Colleges hereby accepts the tuition, program fee, and room and board price recommendations as presented at the September 21, 2022 Board Meeting.
