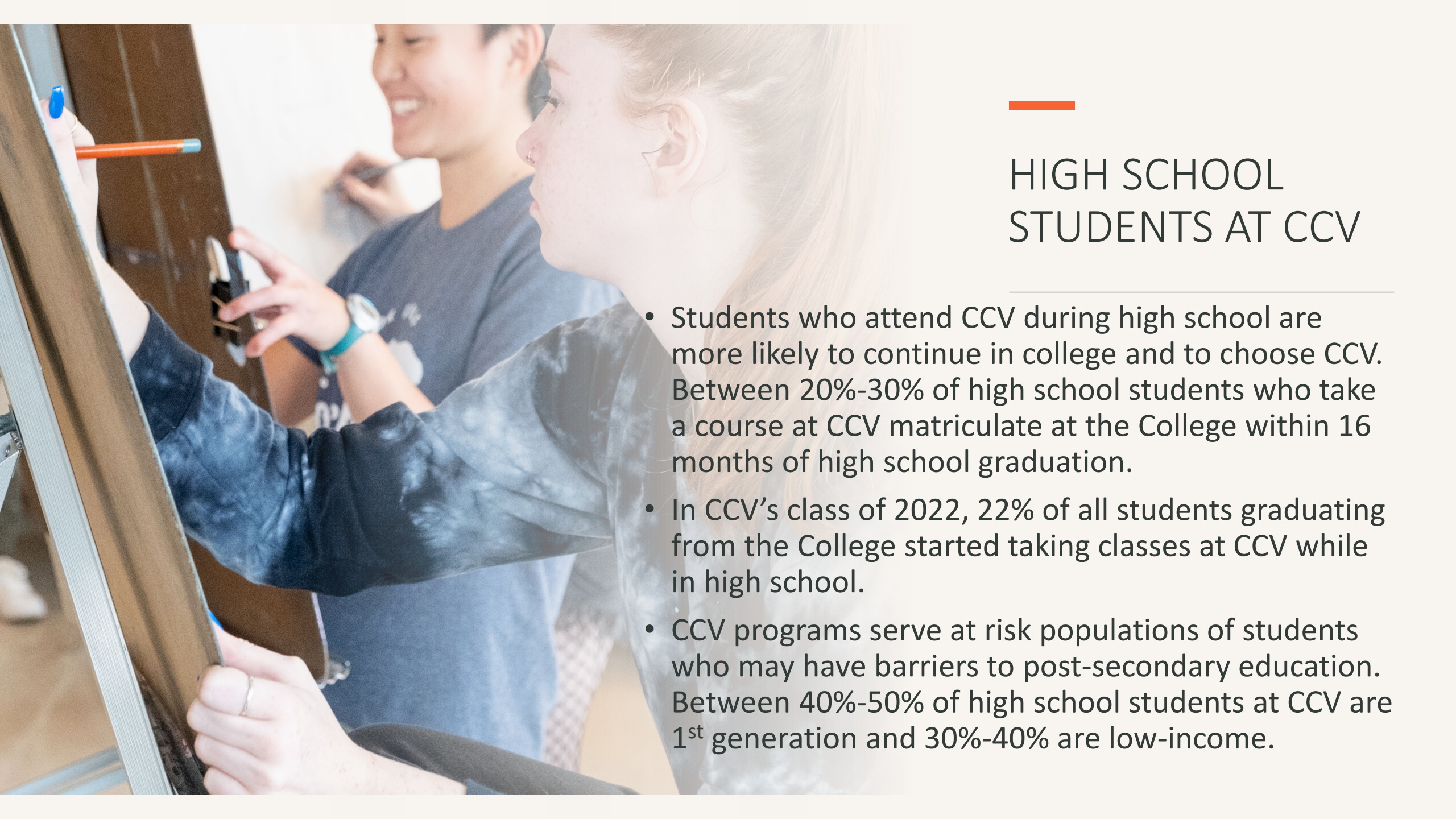
# Statewide Impact

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## HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS AT CCV

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- Students who attend CCV during high school are more likely to continue in college and to choose CCV. Between 20%-30% of high school students who take a course at CCV matriculate at the College within 16 months of high school graduation.
- In CCV's class of 2022, 22% of all students graduating from the College started taking classes at CCV while in high school.
- CCV programs serve at risk populations of students who may have barriers to post-secondary education. Between 40%-50% of high school students at CCV are 1<sup>st</sup> generation and 30%-40% are low-income.
