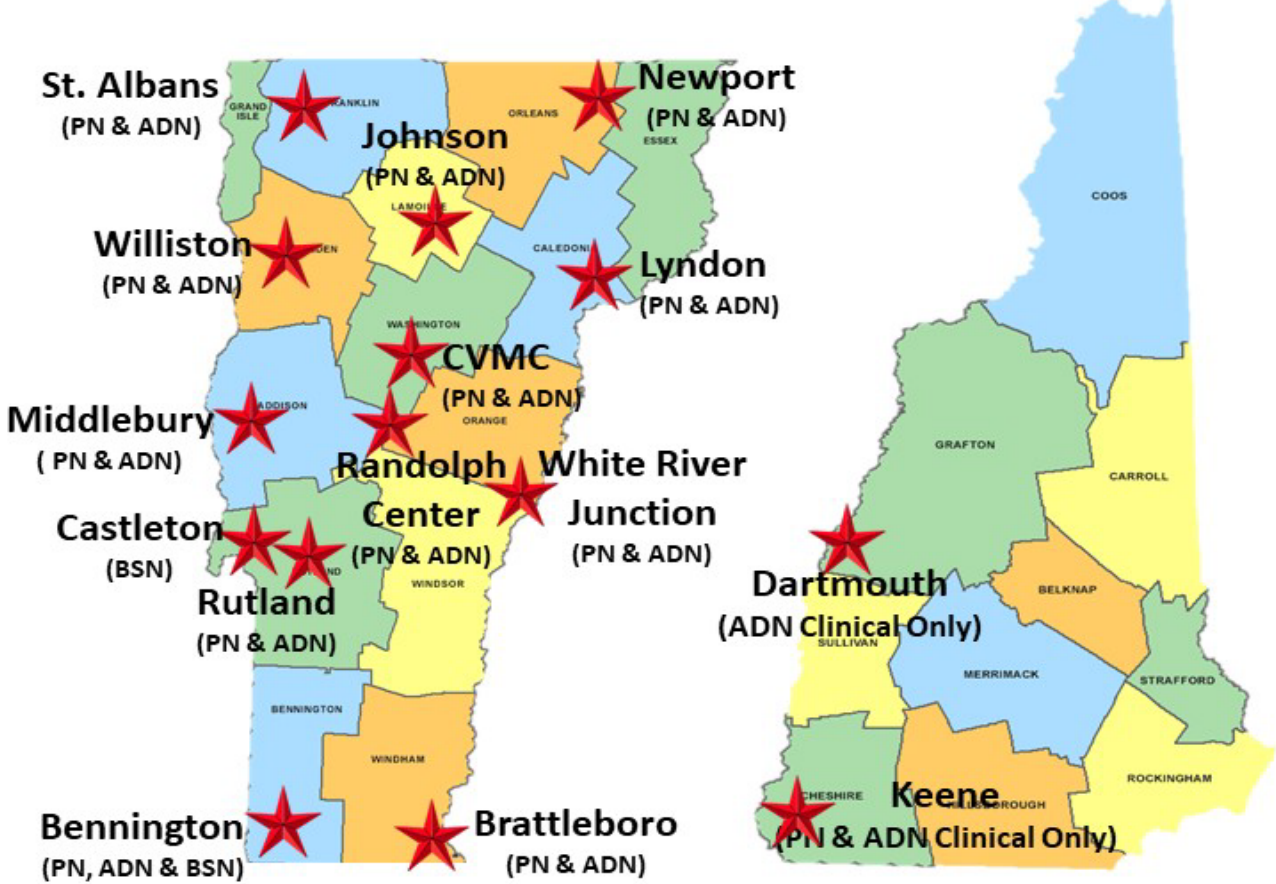

# Legislative Funding - \$800,000

- Simulator Purchases:

  - Castleton - Newborn & 3 Adults
  - Lyndon - Pediatric
  - Randolph - Adult
  - White River Junction - Pediatric
  - Williston - Birthing Adult
- \$747,771.12
- Bed Replacement

# Congressionally Directed Spending - \$6,300,000

- Primarily directed at building new learning spaces
  - Johnson – Nursing Education Center
  - Williston – Nursing Education Spaces
  - Castleton – Telepresence Classroom
- Equipment
  - Lyndon Lab Completion
  - Simulation Power Stretcher
  - AV Installations – Simulation Labs
  - Telepresence Classrooms
  - Additional Bed Replacements

# Nurse Apprenticeship & Pipeline Grant

- State of Vermont – Employers apply & manage fund disbursement
- Supports nursing education for incumbent & new employees
- Employees must earn nursing certificate or degree & start higher level of nursing practice by December 2026
- Two models of implementation & support
  - Individual student sponsorship (students enrolling in existing sites/classes)
  - Employer sponsored cohorts to add to existing sites

  - University of Vermont Medical Center
- Dedicated Seats
  - Brattleboro Memorial Hospital
  - Gifford Medical Center

# Additional Expansions – PN/ADN

- Lyndon
  - New lab space supports increasing to 36-40 seats from 18
- Middlebury
  - Increasing to 18-20 seats from 9
- Randolph
  - Increasing Eve/WE to 40 seats from 20
- Rutland/Castleton
  - Increase to 36-40 seats from 18
