1. Call to Order

Chair Jefferson called the meeting to order at 11:03 a.m.

Chair Jefferson shared that efforts had been made to engage a speaker to present on the United State Supreme Court's decision concerning college admissions and the impact on affirmative action. Scheduling with a speaker did not align for this meeting. However, efforts to schedule are ongoing.

2. Public Comment

Professor Rich Clark shared his hope that Vermont state University will make Diversity, Equity and Inclusion meaningful so "it is felt rather than just spoken" and proposed several ideas that may help the campus community engage with diversity, equity, inclusion and social justice efforts.

3. Approval of Meeting Minutes

Trustee Ragouzis moved and Trustee Bloomer seconded the motion to approve the October 30, 2023 meeting minutes. The motion was approved with one abstention.

4. Welcome Vermont State University's new Chief Diversity Officer

Chair Jefferson welcomed Vermont State University's new Chief Diversity Officer, Dr. Oyibo Afoaku. Dr. Afoaku brings over thirty-five years of executive experience providing strategic initiatives, programs, dialogues, resources, and services pertaining to diversity, equity, and inclusion.

5. Educational Presentation entitled "Calling-In vs. Calling-Out"

Chair Jefferson invited Mary Brodsky, Community College of Vermont's Dean of People and Culture, to share an education presentation via a "Chat and Chew" format entitled "Calling-In vs. Calling-Out" based on the works of Loretta Ross, Professor and Activist. Dean Brodsky facilitated a conversation based on the articles and information found here and here on pages 9-20.

6. <u>Introduction to anticipated formation of Student Government Association's DEI</u> Committee

Trustee Ragouzis introduced the anticipated creation of the VSC Student Association Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Committee, which he expects to form during the Spring 2024 term. The VSC Student Association is comprised of the student representatives from both VSC member institutions – CCV and VTSU. At present, the proposed committee will be chaired by Ashlesha Mainali, a Junior at Vermont State University – Castleton campus.

7. Other Business
