SCREENING QUESTIONS: TECHNOLOGY-ENABLED ABUSE

2. What is their job title? Have they ever worked in the technology field?
3. Would you describe them as tech-savvy (comfortable setting up devices, troubleshooting tech issues, navigating the settings of smartphone or computer, etc.)?
4. Who set up your home wifi? Your smartphone? Your computer or laptop?
5. Would you describe yourself as being tech-savvy (comfortable setting up devices, troubleshooting tech issues, navigating the settings of smartphone or computer, etc.)? If not, why not?
6. Does the other party know any of your passwords? Have they ever logged into or used your online accounts?
7. Have they ever used your smartphone, laptop, computer or other device? If yes, which ones?
8. Do share any accounts (email, banking, shopping, cell phone provider, etc.) with the other party? If yes, which ones?
9. Have you ever had the feeling or sense that the other party knows something (like your location or information you shared in a private text message or email to someone) but can't explain it? If yes, what happened and when?
10. Have you received any emails or text messages notifying you of a security alert (login requests, attempts to reset passwords, etc.) on one of your accounts?
11. Is your smartphone, device or computer acting strangely (turning off unexpectedly, acting glitchy, losing battery quickly, feeling hot to the touch, etc.)?
12. Are you experiencing an increase in calls, messages or emails from blocked or unfamiliar numbers or accounts?
13. Have you ever logged into your online accounts on the other person's device (their smartphone, computer, tablet, etc.)?
14. When did you last update your passwords? Which accounts?
